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Fund Commentary

Global equity markets moved higher in August seemingly boosted by positive market sentiment following dovish monetary policy remarks by the U.S. Federal Reserve. High-growth technology U.S. equities led the charge lifted by strong second quarter earnings results and expectations of interest rates remaining low this year. The Polen Capital Global Growth Fund (the Fund) returned 2.92 per cent versus the MSCI ACWI in Australian dollars, which returned 3.09 per cent.

The top three absolute contributors to performance were Alphabet, Microsoft, and Adobe.

The communication services sector contributed the most to relative performance, driven primarily by stock selection and an overweight position in companies with robust gains during the month. Alphabet led relative performance as the company continues to benefit from a widespread recovery in the market for digital advertising. Stock selection within the health care sector also contributed to relative returns, led by Abbott Laboratories.

Abbott saw demand for its COVID-19 products increase amid a surge in cases caused by the Delta variant.

Stock selection within the information technology sector detracted from relative performance, led by Mastercard and Visa. Shares may have been affected by investor profit-taking following strong price performances. Consumer discretionary also detracted from relative performance due to stock selection, led by Adidas.

Polen Capital continue to believe that the Portfolio is well-positioned for long-term growth. Despite the different styles that will inevitably drift in and out of favour during the coming quarters, Polen Capital feel confident that their disciplined and consistent investment approach will stand up well and the underlying earnings growth of the Portfolio will drive the long-term investment outcome. Polen Capital also believe the secular tailwinds that many of our businesses are benefitting from will persist for years to come.


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
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GICS Sector Exposure
